

# The New Moon Eclipse Thru the Natal Houses



**The first house is Aries ruled by Mars** and is your immediate surroundings, your physical body, especially the head and face, your health, accidents, arrivals, the present or today. Can bring new ventures and beginnings, especially in your immediate environment and your personality, how you dress and how people see you!
